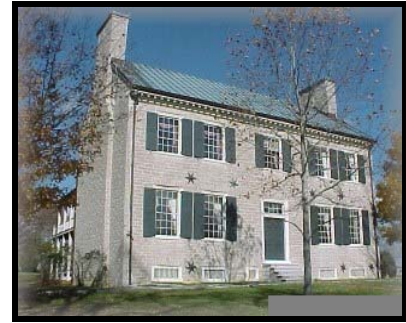


See Sumner's Treasures...Gallatin, TN One Day Itinerary

Begin the day with a tour of **Cragfont**, built by General James Winchester who was a founder of Memphis. Referred to as "The Grandeur of the Frontier," it was the first home with a ballroom in Tennessee, and had parties with guests including Andrew Jackson and Sam Houston. (1 hour, \$4.00 pp)



The **Historic Gallatin Square** is your next stop. Enjoy lunch on your own in one of the restaurants on the newly renovated square. After lunch browse through the shops including the Antique Mall, women's clothing shops and book store. (Lunch on your own)

You can't leave the square without visiting **The Palace Theater**, the oldest movie theater still in its original location in the South. Feel like a kid again while watching a classic television show in the restored theater. (1 hr, \$4.00 pp for the theater, add \$2.00 for popcorn and soda)



Next, tour beautiful **Rose Mont**, once part of a 500 acre plantation that raised thoroughbred horses. Hear how this home was affected by the Civil War, and what national figure visited the home in World War II. (1 hr, \$4.00)

End your tour of Gallatin relaxing on a **peaceful river cruise** aboard the vessel *Discovery*. Captain Jessie will guide you through beautiful scenery with a few surprises along the way. (1 ½ hr, \$9.00. Group size over 25 will be split between Rose Mont and the river cruise)
